The **Spanish-Polish Mathematical Meeting** is a joint initiative of *Polskie Towarzystwo Matematyczne* (PTM = Polish Mathematical Society) and three societies from Spain: *Real Sociedad Matemática Española* (RSME), *Sociedad Española de Matemática Aplicada* (SEMA), and *Societat Catalana de Matemàtiques* (SCM). Developing the cooperation between mathematicians from Spain and Poland is the main goal of the project.

The meeting will be hosted in Łódź by **Uniwersytet Łódzki** and **Politechnika Łódzka**. The event starts in the morning of September 4th (Monday) and ends in the afternoon of September 8th (Friday). All the information on the ES-PL is available at es-pl.math.uni.lodz.pl.

The organizers hope that your participation in the congress as well as your stay in Łódź will be an enjoyable and fruitful experience.

Travel

By plane

Łódź has only small airport (**LCJ – Lodz Aiport Central Poland**) with a few of international connection. The city center is easy accessible by city bus (number 65, ca. 5 PLN) or taxi (ca. 50 PLN).

The most suitable airport for travel to Łódź is **Warsaw Chopin Airport (WAW)** located 130 km from Łódź.

For the convenience of participants we will arrange **dedicated buses from WAW to hotels in Łódź for the participants (cost 10 EUR).** For this matter we need information from persons interested in such a way of travel up to August 15th. Simply write to the meeting email es-pl@math.uni.lodz.pl

From WAW airport you can go to Łódź also by Flixbus (cost ca. 60 PLN, booking at: <https://shop.flixbus.pl/>) or by train changing at Warszawa Gdańska (ca. 45 PLN, in this case consult rozklad.pkp.pl/en). The latest one is not very easy due to reconstructions of train tracks in Warsaw.

Another possible airport is **Warszawa Modlin (WMI)** located to the north of Warsaw. From WMI you should go by local bus and then by train (cf. rozklad.pkp.pl/en). On demand of participants we can arrange our dedicated bus also from WMI airport.

By train

In Łódź there is a main station Łódź Fabryczna in the strict center and two others for long-distance trains Łódź Widzew and Łódź Kaliska. The timetable of Polish railways (PKP) is available at rozklad.pkp.pl/en

By car

The city of Łódź is well connected to other Polish cities by motorways A1, A2, S8 and S14.
